- Applicants should list actual volunteer service hours that have been performed through school, church or community organizations. We want to know specifically what you did – not just the name of the organization. Your service to the school and the community, as well as the PTSA, is important.
- We will take into consideration your financial need as described by you (optional).
- All applicants should demonstrate initiative by completing the application as early as possible. No applications will be accepted after the submission deadline of Friday March 29, 2019.
