Selection will be based on the following criteria:

- **All applicants must be current PTSA members. You must have joined the PTSA before December 31, 2023.** Special consideration will be given to those students who have actively supported PTSA programs and events so please specifically identify any volunteer hours on behalf of the PTSA in your documentation for all 4 high school years.
- **MUST work a minimum of 2 verified 2024 TPC shifts** (may designate a representative to fill in for you). **REQUIRED: Total of 12 volunteer hours through the 2023-2024 PTSA volunteer opportunities** (including TPC).
- All applicants MUST have a minimum 2.0 GPA. (Copy of transcript required).
- One letter of recommendation **from a Fletcher school staff member** (ex: teacher, counselor, coach, etc.).
- Applicants should list volunteer service hours that have been performed through school, church or community organizations. Please list specific information and not just the name of the organization.
- All applicants should demonstrate initiative by completing the application as early as possible. No applications will be accepted after the submission deadline of **Sunday, April 21, 2024**.
- Any forms missing documentation and requirements will cause automatic disqualification.
